Cancellations

We have a sliding scale of cancellation charges to cover lost bookings due to late cancellations. We will waive these if we get a replacement booking for the same period.

Cancellation	Charge
3 months or more before booking	The £250 deposit
Between 2 & 3 months before	50% of fee
Between 1 & 2 months before	75% of fee
Less than 1 month before	Full fee

We also reserve the right to charge for any damage by guests to our property.

To make a booking

Our Facilities

Unstone Grange is a Victorian house set in nearly 5 acres of beautiful grounds and gardens, which we look after according to organic and permaculture principles.

As a Centre for Personal Creative Growth we want to encourage people to come here to work on consciously moving forward in their own lives in whatever way is appropriate for them at the time.. We welcome group bookings throughout the year

We have 3 group rooms, including the dining room, a good sized kitchen, 10 bedrooms with up to 36 bed spaces, a large barn, a camping field, lawns and gardens.

You can book the Grange in different ways -

Self catered - The group do all their own cooking, and bring their own bed linen:- 2 sheets and a pillowcase per person.

Fully catered - This includes a self-serve breakfast, lunch and evening meal (we do our best to accommodate dietary needs), and drinks and biscuits at break times.

We provide bed linen and do the end of stay cleaning.

Our Residential Charges

Cost per 24 hours

Residential

A residential booking includes at least one overnight stay and two nights at weekends

Self catered **£25.00 per person**
At weekends, the minimum booking is for 15 people*.

Fully catered **Get in touch for prices**
At all times, the minimum booking is for 15 people*.

At Christmas and New Year the minimum is 20*.

***You may bring a smaller group but we must still charge for these minimum numbers.**

For large groups and groups with children please talk to us about a discount.
